Myth #1: “The First Thanksgiving” occurred in 1621 Fact: No one knows when the “first” thanksgiving occurred People have been giving thanks for as long as people have existed Indigenous nations all over the world have celebrations of the harvest that come from very old traditions; for Native peoples, thanksgiving comes not once a
